Consistent United Local Prayer for our Leaders and Nation

(I Tim 2., II Chron. 7:14)

1. Consistent united local prayer for over 12 years – a Marathon Ministry Mindset rather than just prayer “projects” or “events:”
Group has met consistently on the First Saturday to pray for our leaders and nation (I Tim. 2, II Chron. 7:14) since 2001.
2. Prayer group frequency, timing, and format:
Prayer group meets consistently on the First Saturday of every month from 7 to 8:15AM. If more than 15 people attend, we have prayer as a group for first half and then break up into groups of 3 to 5 after that.
3. Why pray for our leaders and nation?
Prayer is commanded for our leaders and nation (I Tim. 2, II Chron. 7:14), but is also the key to spiritual awakening, revival, and possibly Great Awakening. People who come are so encouraged and enthusiastic. We had between 45 and 50 united in prayer in June!
4. Growing the prayer group:
Publicity, spreading the word, has been challenge. To invite people, we use word of mouth, Email reminders, and lately free Klov announcements as a main source of new people.
5. Additional work:
We believe that standing for life, marriage, and America’s Biblical foundation is a great **moral duty**, and essential to the preservation of our ongoing liberty to freely evangelize. Therefore, around Election time, we distribute non-partisan Voter Guides to help people of Judeo-Christian faith to discern the values of the local, state, and federal candidates, and to select God-fearing leaders (Exod, 18:21) who will preserve America’s Biblical foundation and the liberty it gives to freely evangelize.
Preserving the holy cause of liberty for evangelical purposes is our loving, moral, Biblical duty.

Wayne Bigelow was born and raised in Turlock, California, about 90 minutes south of Sacramento. He attended San Jose Bible College (now William Jessup University) where he received his Bachelor’s in Theology, and he also earned a Bachelor’s Degree from UC Berkeley.
